

Pratap Public School, Jundla, proudly presents its Annual Report for the academic session 2024–25, highlighting a year of academic excellence, skill enrichment, and holistic growth in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, under the visionary leadership of our respected Principal, \*Dr. Kusum Ahlawat. In the CBSE Board Examinations 2024, the school achieved a \*\*100% pass rate. Rishab Goel and Bharti scored \*\*95.8%\* in Class XII, and Rinjal scored \*95.4%\* in Class X. Overall, 15 students scored above 80%, 16 above 70%, and 31 above 60%. In Fine Arts, students including Radhika, Uday, Rishabh, Tanish, Kashish, Nargis, Gurleen, and Aaditya scored a perfect \*100/100\* in Class XII Boards.

At the international level, our students participated in the INTERNATIONAL LEGEND ARTIST AWARD SHOW & International Online Exhibition 2024 (Season 3), hosted in West Bengal, with entries from over 10 countries. \*Tanish, Sanjana, and Taniya\* won \*Winner Awards, while \*\*Yashika, Vanshika, Bharti, Mahak, Aditi, Samta, Simran, and Vanhika\* earned \*Selection and Participation Awards. In Olympiads, Mudit and Sameer won medals in Hindi; Yashika, Gursidak, and Niket earned gold in English and Hindi; Chancy and Aarav Bhardwaj excelled in Mathematics; and Jaspreet, Gevansh, and Joban Singh topped in Science Olympiads. Over \*\*150 students\* received participation certificates in Hindi, Science, and Mathematics Olympiads.

In co-curricular achievements, \*Pragati Sharma (Class XI Commerce)\* secured \*2nd position\* in the Golden Brush Awards 2024 Calligraphy Competition held at Buddha College on \*30th November, winning a \*\*trophy, certificate, and ₹1500 cash prize. The school earned \*\*3rd place\* in the Patriotic Group Song at the District Council for Child Welfare Children Day Competition. Students also won the \*Consolation Prize and ₹1000\* in the \*District Level Shabad Gayan Competition\* at Guru Teg Bahadur School, Karnal.

A key highlight of the year was the electrifying \*U-14 Rising Star Kabaddi League, hosted on \*\*October 26, 2024, for Classes VI–VIII. The inter-house event fostered teamwork and resilience. \*\*Team Narmada\* won the championship in a thrilling final against \*Team Satluj, after semi-final victories over \*\*Brahmaputra\* and \*Ganga\* respectively. The event was graced by \*Sarpanch Satish Narwal Ji, \*\*Block Samiti Chairman Sardar Sukhdev Singh Ji, \*\*Gram Sarpanch Krishna Devi Ji, \*\*Nambardar Malkhan Singh Ji, and \*\*Junior Wing Incharge Ms. Jyoti Nijhawan, alongside \*\*Dr. Kusum Ahlawat, who all inspired and congratulated the participants. Notably, \*\*Sarpanch Satish Narwal Ji\* announced a \*tree plantation drive\* along the school road in honor of management members, while \*Chairman Sardar Sukhdev Singh Ji\* declared a \*cash prize of ₹1,00,000\* for students ranking in the \*Top 10 in CBSE Class X & XII\*, to encourage academic excellence.

In sports, the school hosted the \*U-11 Grassroot Football Championship, where \*\*Brahmaputra House\* defeated \*Yamuna House\* in a close final. \*Abhishek (IV C)\* was named Best Player, and \*Aarav (V A)\* won Best Goalkeeper. Other sports achievements include \*Sawan (Class X)\* qualifying in High Jump (U-17), \*Tanish (Class VII)\* in Volleyball (U-14), and \*Harshit (Class VI)\* in Kabaddi (U-14).

Further aligning with NEP's skill-based education, a \*Skill Excellence Workshop on Mushroom Cultivation\* was conducted by \*Dr. O.P. Ahlawat\*, Principal Scientist and Head, Department of Crop Improvement, at the Indian Institute of Wheat and Barley Research Karnal, (ICAR) . He provided in-depth knowledge and hands-on learning in mushroom farming to empower students with agricultural skills.

Throughout the year, various student workshops, teacher training programs, and co-curricular activities like Calligraphy, Drawing, Painting, Poem Recitation, Singing, Dancing, Maths & Science Quizzes, Role Plays, and sports were organized to foster creativity, collaboration, and character.
